In addition, the outcomes of this important work will be helpful for leadership, education, youth programs and other supports to listen to youth and be the best supports to them in 2024.

Each day will include off site recreation and community building activities, including a safe and supported event on New Years Eve in Ottawa,

Ontario.

Sharing moments that matter, while celebrating the identity of the young people, is one of the strategies our Gatherings undertakes, lifting up both the voices and spirits of youth and allies alike.
